Level 2 (2A and 2B) gives -

Limited command of the language in a range of familiar situations

The candidate can at the end of the program:

1. Share personal information
2. Ask for and give opinions, reasons
3. Describe needs and future plans
4. Relate past events and experiences
5. Follow basic rules and regulations
6. Make simple telephone calls
7. Complain and apologize
8. Suggest and recommend
9. Understand simple instructions
10. Confirm and change travel plans
11. Recognise basic formal and informal language

Level 3 (3A and 3B) gives –

Effective command of the language in a fair number of situations

The candidate can at the end of the program:

1. Discuss personal objectives
2. Ask for and give advice
3. Express and defend points of view
4. Debate current affairs
5. Talk of leisure and lifestyle
6. Make complex travel arrangements
7. Deal with customs, immigration
8. Write short formal letters
9. Speculate on cause and effect
10. Follow news and press ads
11. Recognise common idioms and humorous references
